



Walter Reed LRA & ULI Washington Technical Assistance Panel: Presentation on a Temporary Use Framework for Walter Reed

The Office of the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development, acting as the Walter Reed Local Redevelopment Authority (LRA), recently engaged the Washington, DC office of the Urban Land Institute (ULI Washington) to convene a Technical Assistance Panel (TAP) April 1-2, 2013 to examine the feasibility and potential of temporary uses on the District's portion of the former Walter Reed Army Medical Center. Through the TAP program, ULI Washington is able to deliver honest, unbiased answers to land use and real estate questions that defy easy solutions.

After becoming acquainted with the Site and discussing questions raised by the LRA, the TAP will present their recommendations and findings on April 2nd. A final report of the TAP will be published on the LRA website in May.
